for vulnerabilities whose code patterns are spread out across the boundaries of single methods and classes these patterns are identified using the graph query language cypher which is provided by the graph database neo4j in an evaluation run on 100 public repositories on github using cryptography 135 findings of cryptographic api misuse have been identified using this technique these include the use of insecure algorithms like the data encryption standard des or electronic code book mode ecb and hardcoded passwords that are used for encryption purposes this thesis has been created in cooperation with fraunhofer aisec
